

Inspira Update – September 2024 (2)

This Inspira update provides information on the Aula-Inspira integration upgrade which now includes grade pass back to Aula. As the integration is between Aula and the Inspira production server the update also includes a reminder on the two Inspira servers, the test server which is the staff only development space and the production server, to be used for delivery of assessments to students.

Aula-Inspira Integration

The upgrade to the Aula-Inspira integration has now been released, this includes providing grade pass back from Inspira to Aula.

The upgrade adds a new integration to the Aula **Assignment block**. The existing integration, where links can be added to content pages in **Journey > Materials**, remains.

The differences between the two integrations are:

- Assignment Block integration
 - Provides grade pass back to Aula
 - Students are pulled through from Aula to Inspira, so where students need additional time this can be added before they start the assessment.
 - **This integration must be used for summative assessments**
- Journey > Materials integration
 - **It is recommended that this integration is used for formative assessments** as it does not provide grade pass back to Aula. In addition students are not pulled through from Aula to Inspira.

Inspira Test and Production tenancies

It is a requirement to attend the 'Getting Started with Inspira' training before being added to Inspira. You will have been given access to the Test tenancy following this training. The Test tenancy is staff only access and should be used as a sand-pit space for Question Set development. The Production server is where students have access and for delivery of all assessments.
